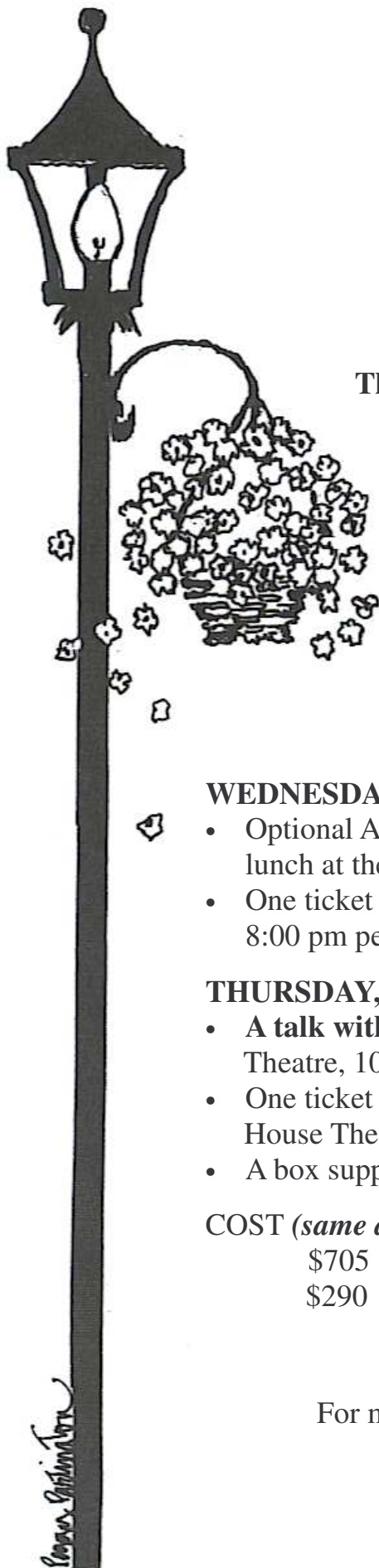

INCLUDED PLAYS

Harvey by Mary Chase, directed by Joseph Ziegler - A new look at a Pulitzer Prize-winning play, made famous by Jimmy Stewart's portrayal of the loveable Elwood Dowd in the 1950 film. Everyone wants to meet Elwood Dowd and his friend Harvey, a six-foot invisible rabbit.

The Women by Clare Boothe Luce, directed by Alisa Palmer – A revealing look into the lives of the ladies-who-do-lunch that is clever, cut-throat and full of outrageous humor. A Manhattan socialite finds out her husband is cheating on her, and her girlfriends are no help at all.

The Cherry Orchard by Anton Chekhov, adapted by Tom Murphy, directed by Jason Byrne – An adaptation of Chekhov's final play by one of Ireland's leading contemporary playwrights. An aristocratic family's way of life seems to be disappearing, and with it, their beloved cherry orchard.

OPTIONAL ACTIVITY

Wednesday, June 16th 10:00 a.m. – LEARN MORE ABOUT NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE. For an additional cost to be determined, sign-up for a guided tour of the Niagara Historical Society and Museum and its exhibits, followed by lunch at the Irish Harp pub. The Society was established in 1895 and consists of three buildings - Memorial Hall (built in 1906), the High School (built in 1875) and the Link building (built in 1971). The Museum houses one of the finest collections of early Canadian artifacts and archives.
