



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## Summer Remote Learning: Ages 20+ Course Descriptions

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
<b>Audition Prep</b>	As an actor, auditioning is part of your job. So why do we put so much stress on the process? Sign up for Audition Process where you will learn the ins and outs of nailing your next audition, selecting an appropriate monologue, creating the perfect 16-32 bar cut, and much more.
<b>Creativity Clinic</b>	Where does creativity come from? Can you be creative if you don't consider yourself an artist? Set up as a fun, non-threatening, encouraging atmosphere, this online class will explore the idea of creativity in your own life... perhaps revealing a creative side you never knew existed.
<b>Directing Basics</b>	In this course students will learn how to create look books, what goes into a director's notebook, and how to be a better collaborator. Students will be asked to generate material from a play provided by the instructor and one of their own choosing.
<b>Improvisation</b>	Participants will have the opportunity of exploring conflict, actions, objectives, subtext, emotional truth, trust, rhythm, playfulness and instinct, through a series of drama games, exercises and challenges. It will be fun!
<b>InsideCPH: Artistic Conversations</b>	This six-part InsideCPH series will explore how local and national theatre artists are being impacted by this pandemic and how they are creatively coping. These honest and, at times, very humorous conversations will celebrate the work these artists have created at CPH in the past and offer a sneak peek at the plans being dreamed up for the future. The series will bring audiences closer to the creative practices and artists they love. Get ready for some surprising and inspiring stories! Join CPH Artistic Director Laura Kepley and her weekly guest every Thursday night! Event will include the opportunity for audiences to ask the artists questions.
<b>Lunchtime Meditation</b>	This course will explore practical methods that performers use as a means to quiet their minds and release the tension in their bodies. Students will work to apply new and valuable insights gained through focused reflection to one's own life and character. Methods will include breathing techniques, stretching, tai chi, guided meditation, extramusical association and prayer.
<b>Puppetry for All Ages</b>	Expressing ourselves through puppetry is an age-old human activity. And it's just plain fun. Within a warm, non-threatening, encouraging atmosphere, we'll take advantage of this time of social distancing and isolation to dip into our creative side, making puppets from items we find just lying around us.
<b>Scene Study</b>	Students will have the opportunity to work on scenes from contemporary playwrights and explore conflict, actions, objectives, subtext and emotional truth. Different levels of experience and training are welcome.
